Paper Submission Procedure

Extended abstracts (2 pages) should be submitted in PDF format through E2KW website (<http://congresse2kw.uclm.es/submissions/>) by August 5th 2014 to be included in the final E2KW programme. An additional front page of the document should include the title, authors, affiliations and contact details. The abstracts should contain necessarily the following information:

- Purpose.
- Design/methodology/approach.
- Results/Findings.
- Conclusions.
